Vision:

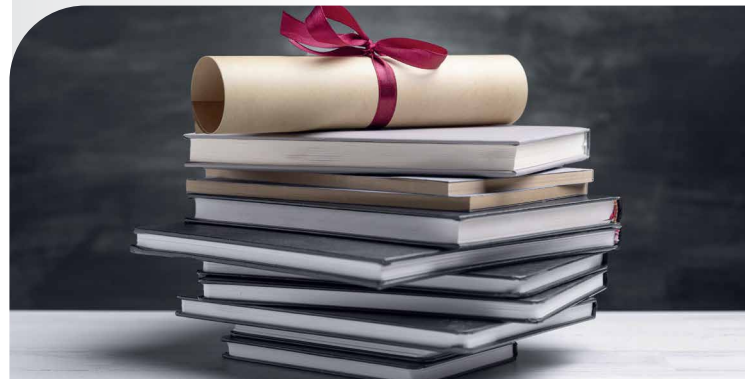
Excellence and leadership in graduate programs locally and regionally.

Requirements for Application to the Master's Program:

1. The applicant must have a bachelor's degree with a grade point average of at least "Good" for Jordanians or its equivalent from a university recognized by the Jordanian Ministry of Higher Education.
2. The bachelor's degree should be in the field of specialization or a related field of study, per the study plan of the program.
3. The applicant must prove that he/she has obtained a bachelor's degree through regular study.
4. Applicants with a bachelor's degree may be admitted with a "Fair" for non-Jordanians grade point average, in accordance with the regulations of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research.
5. Applicants for admission to the Master's programs must present proof of passing the TOEFL or an equivalent test. Otherwise, they are required to pass the English proficiency courses offered by the University during the first semester of the program, per the regulations of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research.



Requirements for Application to the High Diploma Program:

1. The applicant must have a bachelor's degree from a university recognized by the Jordanian Ministry of Higher Education.
2. The bachelor's degree should be in the field of specialization or a related field of study, per the placement of the Council and a recommendation from the College and Department Councils, in accordance with the study plan of the program.
3. Applicants with a bachelor's degree with a "Fair" grade point average or higher may apply for admission to the Higher Diploma Program.
4. Any applicant who has a bachelor's degree by affiliation may apply for admission to the Higher Diploma Program, provided that the major of the Higher Diploma at the University matches that of his bachelor's degree.
